NOTE 4# This new database is still very much under development, and I would greatly welcome any additions or corrections to this list. Most DGPS Beacons are unmanned and reports will often have to be sent via a central address, these are given where known, along with e-mail addresses for e-reports. Names or verification signers, or addresses that are known to have worked are included, but many have not been confirmed yet so details can't all be guaranteed to be 100% accurate. Many of the addresses are thought to be useful starting places, but may not work, or at best will just get your reports forwarded on to the correct department, in such cases I would greatly appreciate any correct details that may have worked for you, and in particular, e-mail addresses, as many Dxers now like to try this quicker (and cheaper) route for their reception reports.
